ORDINANCE NO. 2024-004 Series of 2024

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE PROVINCIAL PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICE OFFICE OF THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL AND VARIOUS POSITIONS UNDER THE SAID OFFICE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, unemployment and underemployment continue to be the perennial problems of the country and the Province of Negros Occidental and these problems can be attributed to various factors such as (1) inability of our economy to generate adequate jobs; (2) labor market imperfections; (3) lack of information about the market demand;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Negros Occidental has long been implementing job opportunities and generation programs for its people, and continue to partner and strengthen the employment promotions program of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) for the purpose of uplifting the human resources and development in the province;

WHEREAS, RA No. 10691, An Act Defining the Role of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), the Local Government Units (LGUs), and Accredited Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) in the Establishment and Operation of the Public Employment Service Office (PESO), and the Operation of Job Placement Offices in Educational Institutions (EIs), Amending For the Purpose Sections 3, 5, 6, 7 and 9 of Republic Act 8759, Otherwise Known as the "Public Employment Service Office Act of 1999";

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental in a Regular Session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF THE PROVINCIAL PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICE OFFICE OF THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL AND VARIOUS POSITIONS UNDER THE SAID OFFICE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR. - The Provincial Public Employment Service Office of the Province of Negros Occidental is hereby created.

SECTION 2. CREATION OF VARIOUS POSITIONS. – The following positions are hereby created under the Provincial Public Employment Service Office of the Province of Negros Occidental, to wit:

SECTION 3. ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND STAFFING PATTERN. – The new Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern and Personnel schedule of the Provincial Public Employment Service Office of the Province of Negros Occidental are hereby created and adopted, as shown in Annex "A" of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Separability Clause. – If any provision of the Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions unaffected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 5. Repealing Clause. – All other ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby revoked, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval thereof.
