***RESOLUTION DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 078, SERIES OF 2024 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ENRIQUE AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RIZAL STREET STARTING CORNER RIZAL - MONTINOLA STREETS (BANGGA MUNISIPYO) TO CORNER OF RIZAL - DULACA STREETS (BANGGA ESKWELAHAN) DURING THE STREET DANCE COMPETITION IN CELEBRATION OF THE 105<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL TOWN FIESTA AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE***

***WHEREAS***, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

***WHEREAS***, Municipal Ordinance No. 078, series of 2024 of the Municipality of San Enrique authorizing the temporary closure of Rizal Street starting corner of Rizal – Montinola Streets (Bangga Munisipyo) to corner of Rizal Street – Dulaca Streets (Bangga Eskwelahan) during the Street Dance Competition in celebration of the 105<sup>th</sup> Annual Town Fiesta was submitted for review by the Municipality of San Enrique to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

**WHEREAS**, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Bayan of San Enrique enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

**WHEREAS**, the enactment of the subject Ordinance finds legal basis in the Local Government Code, to wit:

*"Article 447. (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code; and*

*SEC. 21. Closure and Opening of Roads. - (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction: Provided, however, That in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided.*

*(c) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during an actual emergency, or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order*




**WHEREAS**, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Laws recommends approval of the same;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr., and unanimously seconded by all members present,

**THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED**, as it hereby resolves, to approve this resolution to wit:
