**RESOLUTION DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 2024-125 OF THE CITY OF VICTORIAS ESTABLISHING PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY STANDARDS AGAINST FOOD AND WATER BORNE DISEASES WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORIAS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH RA NO. 11332, RA NO. 10611 AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES, AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it's consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2024-125 of the City of Victorias establishing public health and safety standards against food and water borne diseases within the City of Victorias, in accordance with RA No. 11332, RA No. 10611 and the Local Government Code of the Philippines, was submitted for review by the City of Victorias to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

**WHEREAS**, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Constitution covenants that, "the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them."

**WHEREAS**, the subject ordinance finds legal basis under the Local Government Code to wit:



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(Page 2, Res. 0815, series of 2024)

*"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."*

*"(a) The Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under section 22*

**WHEREAS**, the instant ordinance further finds legal support from Republic Act No. 11332 and Republic Act No. 10611 which, respectively, mandates the necessity of reporting the existence of diseases and the observance of health standards to protect public health.

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr. unanimously seconded by all the members present during the regular session of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental, resolved, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution to wit:
