RESOLUTION DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-005 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE EXPANDING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG PUBLIC CEMETERY AT BRGY. DANCALAN AND PROVIDING GUDELINES FOR ITS USE, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE INCLUDING THE COLLECTION OF FEES AND CHARGES AND IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ARTICLE B, CHAPTER IV AND ARTICLE D, CHAPTER V OF THE REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG" AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Bayan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlangsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 2024-005 of the Municipality of Ilog, Negros Occidental, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE EXPANDING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG PUBLIC CEMETERY AT BRGY. DANCALAN AND PROVIDING GUDELINES FOR ITS USE, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE, INCLUDING THE COLLECTION OF FEES AND CHARGES AND IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ARTICLE B, CHAPTER IV AND ARTICLE D, CHAPTER V OF THE REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG" was submitted for review by the Municipality of Ilog to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Bayan of Ilog enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, Section 447 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160), empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to enact ordinances for the promotion of the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, to wit:

SECTION 447. Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. - (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants. xxx"

Subject to the provisions of Book II of this Code, grant franchises, enact ordinances authorizing the issuance of permits or licenses, or enact ordinances levying taxes, fees and charges upon such conditions and for such purposes intended to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality, and pursuant to this legislative authority shall:

Fix and impose reasonable fees and charges for all services rendered by the municipal government to private persons or entities;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Ilog, through its legislative body, is empowered to prescribe the rates and charges, including penalties, related to the utility of a public cemetery.

WHEREAS, considering that the subject ordinance is one with revenue measures, the mandatory requirement of a public hearing under Sections 186 & 187 & publication in full for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of local circulation under Section 188 (for revenue ordinance); of R.A. 7160, must be duly complied with Sections 187 and 188 of RA 7160, to wit:

Sec. 187. Procedure for Approval and Effectivity of Tax, Ordinances and Revenue Measures; Mandatory Public Hearing.- The procedure for approval of local tax ordinances and revenue measures shall be in accordance with the provisions of this Code: Provided, That public hearings shall be conducted for the purpose prior to the enactment thereof: xxx"

Sec. 188. Publication of Tax Ordinances and Revenue Measures. - Within ten (10) days after their approval, certified true copies of all provincial, city, and municipal tax ordinances or revenue measures shall be published in full for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of local circulation; the same may be posted in at least two (2) conspicuous and publicly accessible places.

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental, which are:

- 1. It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.
- 2. It must not be unfair or oppressive.
- 3. It must not be partial or discriminatory.
- 4. It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.
- 5. It must be general and consistent with public policy.
- It must not be unreasonable.

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;
