RESOLUTION DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 24-25 OF THE CITY OF BAGO, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, AMENDING ARTICLE XII, SECTION 76 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 19-13 OR THE CHILDREN'S WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT CODE, INCORPORATING FOR THE PURPOSE THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10152 OR AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MANDATORY BASIC IMMUNIZATION SERVICES FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN, REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 996, AS AMENDED, BY ADDING SUB-SECTION 44 AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 24-25 of the City of Bago, Negros Occidental entitled: "An Ordinance amending Article XII, Section 76 of City Ordinance No. 19-13 or the Children's Welfare and Development Code, incorporating for the purpose the applicable provisions of Republic Act No. 10152 or an act providing for mandatory basic immunization services for infants and children, repealing for the purpose Presidential Decree No. 996, as amended, by adding Sub-Section 44" was submitted for review by the City of Bago to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bago to enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, the subject ordinance finds legal basis under the Local Government Code, to wit:

“Article 458. (a) The sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 16 of this Code xxx:”

WHEREAS, there is currently under review an amendatory ordinance that modifies Article XII, Section 76 of Ordinance No. 19-13 by adding Sub-section 44, thereby incorporating the relevant provisions of R.A. 10152. This amendment is considered to align with applicable laws, and the adoption of the amendatory ordinance falls within the authority of the concerned sanggunian. According to the submitted certification, posting was conducted in accordance with Section 511 of R.A. 7160.

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, which are:

1. *It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.*
2. *It must not be unfair or oppressive.*
3. *It must not be partial or discriminatory.*
4. *It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.*
5. *It must be general and consistent with public policy.*
6. *It must not be unreasonable.*

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr., unanimously seconded by all the members present;

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution, to wit:
