RESOLUTION DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 2024-160 OF THE CITY OF VICTORIAS, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL ENTITLED: “AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE SOUTHBOUND LANE OF OSMEÑA AVENUE FROM BARANGAY 1 BANGGA DAAN (TOURJACK MOTOR PARTS) TO WELCOME ARCH/MALOGO RIVER ON DECEMBER 14, 2024, 5:00 AM ONWARDS FOR THE DUATHLON EVENT IN CELEBRATION OF THE 11TH KALAMAYAN FESTIVAL 2024” AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2024-160 of the City of Victorias, Negros Occidental entitled: “AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE SOUTHBOUND LANE OF OSMEÑA AVENUE FROM BARANGAY 1 BANGGA DAAN (TOURJACK MOTOR PARTS) TO WELCOME ARCH/MALOGO RIVER ON DECEMBER 14, 2024, 5:00 AM ONWARDS FOR THE DUATHLON EVENT IN CELEBRATION OF THE 11TH KALAMAYAN FESTIVAL 2024” was submitted for review by the City of Victorias to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, the subject Ordinance finds legal basis under the Local Government Code, to wit:

Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160), "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall x xx, promote health and safety, xxx, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."

And

Section 21. Closure and Opening of Roads. - (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction: xxx. (c) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during an actual emergency, or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order:

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, which are:

1. *It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.*
2. *It must not be unfair or oppressive.*
3. *It must not be partial or discriminatory.*
4. *It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.*
5. *It must be general and consistent with public policy.*
6. *It must not be unreasonable.*

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Laws recommends approval of the same;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr., unanimously seconded by all the members present;

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to declare Ordinance No. 2024-160 of the City of Victorias, Negros Occidental entitled: "AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE SOUTHBOUND LANE OF OSMEÑA AVENUE FROM BARANGAY 1 BANGGA DAAN (TOURJACK MOTOR PARTS) TO WELCOME ARCH/MALOGO RIVER ON DECEMBER 14, 2024, 5:00 AM ONWARDS FOR THE DUATHLON EVENT IN CELEBRATION OF THE 11TH KALAMAYAN FESTIVAL 2024" as a valid enacted Ordinance;
