RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-018 OF THE CITY OF SIPALAY, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, INSTITUTIONALIZING THE INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM (ICS) AND IMPLEMENTING THE GUIDELINES AS THE ON-SCENE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT MECHANISM FOR ALL-HAZARD INCIDENT MANAGEMENT IN THE CITY OF SIPALAY, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 2024-018 of the City of Sipalay, Negros Occidental, entitled: "*AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM (ICS) AND IMPLEMENTING THE GUIDELINES AS THE ON-SCENE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT MECHANISM FOR ALL-HAZARD INCIDENT MANAGEMENT IN THE CITY OF SIPALAY, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL*" was submitted for review by the City of Sipalay to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Sipalay to enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod is vested with the power to enact ordinances by the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) under Article 458 (a) (iv), to wit:

Section 458. Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. (a) The sangguniang panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the city as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall:

- (1) *Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective city government, and in this connection, shall:*

x x x x x x

(iv) *Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events;*

WHEREAS, the enactment of the subject ordinance is, likewise, in consonance with Department of Interior and Local Government Memorandum Circular No. 2015-76 dated July 21, 2016, which enjoins all local executives to “perform early-preparedness actions to reduce disaster risks”, and such includes the establishment of an Incident Command System (ICS) which is “to be activated with reference to National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council Memorandum Circular No. 04, Series of 2012 dated March 28, 2012”;

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, which are:

*It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.
It must not be unfair or oppressive.
It must not be partial or discriminatory.
It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.
It must be general and consistent with public policy.
It must not be unreasonable.*

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr. unanimously seconded by all the members present during the regular session of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution, to wit:
