***RESOLUTION DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 2025-167 OF THE CITY OF VICTORIAS, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, TEMPORARILY CLOSING CORNER JOVER-QUEZON STREETS TO CORNER MONTINOLA-QUEZON STREETS IN THE CITY OF VICTORIAS ON FEBRUARY 10-11, 2025 FROM 8:00 AM TO 11:00 PM, IN CONNECTION WITH THE ACTIVITIES FOR THE BARANGAY IV DAY CELEBRATION AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE***

***WHEREAS***, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

***WHEREAS***, Ordinance No. 2025-167 of the City of Victorias, Negros Occidental entitled: "An Ordinance temporarily closing Corner Jover-Quezon Streets to Corner Montinola-Quezon Streets in the City of Victorias on February 10-11, 2025 from 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM in connection with the activities for the Barangay IV Day Celebration", was submitted for review by the City of Victorias to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

***WHEREAS***, the proposed ordinance of the City of Victorias finds legal support from Section 21 (a) & (c) of the Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, Section 21 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that a local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction. Furthermore, item (c) in the same section states that any national or local road may be temporarily closed during fiesta celebrations. The ordinance is aligned with this act as it seeks to temporarily close Corner Jover-Quezon Streets to Corner Montinola-Quezon Streets for the Barangay IV Day celebration in the City of Victorias;

**WHEREAS**, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, Series of 2024, which are:

1. *It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.*
2. *It must not be unfair or oppressive.*
3. *It must not be partial or discriminatory.*
4. *It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.*
5. *It must be general and consistent with public policy.*
6. *It must not be unreasonable.*

**WHEREAS**, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr. unanimously seconded by all the members present;


**THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED**, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution, to wit:
