RESOLUTION APPROVING ORDINANCE NO. 04-2025 OF THE CITY OF CADIZ, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING MONTHLY HONORARIA TO TWENTY TWO (22) VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN (VAW) DESK OFFICERS IN CADIZ CITY AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF"

WHEREAS, thereby presented for appropriate action of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Negros Occidental is Ordinance No. 04-2025 of the City of Cadiz, Negros Occidental entitled: "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING MONTHLY HONORARIA TO TWENTY TWO (22) VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN (VAW) DESK OFFICERS IN CADIZ CITY AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF";

WHEREAS, the same is mandated under Section 9(d) of RA 9710, otherwise known as the Magna Carta of Women;

WHEREAS, the granting of honoraria is consistent with the policy directive of RA 9710 as it institutionalizes support for gender-responsive mechanisms at the local level and within the scope of the local government unit's authority to determine expenditures that promote public welfare;

WHEREAS, the passage of the subject ordinance falls squarely within the legislative authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod pursuant to Section 447 of the same Code, particularly in protecting women's rights and promoting gender equality through the support of local VAW Desk Officers;

WHEREAS, with respect to the effectivity clause, Section 8 of the ordinance states that it shall have retroactive effect beginning January 2025, and shall take effect after a copy thereof is posted at the bulletin board of the city hall and in at least two (2) conspicuous places in the City of Cadiz, in accordance with Section 59 of RA 7160;
