RESOLUTION DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 25-08 OF THE CITY OF SAN CARLOS, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, ENTITLED: AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE TO ORDINANCE NO. 24-12, GOVERNING THE SAN CARLOS CITY HOSPITAL CONSIGNMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDING VARIOUS REVISIONS THERETO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 25-08 of the City of San Carlos, Negros Occidental, entitled: "*AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE TO ORDINANCE NO. 24-12, GOVERNING THE SAN CARLOS CITY HOSPITAL CONSIGNMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDING VARIOUS REVISIONS THERETO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES*" was submitted for review by the City of San Carlos to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of San Carlos to enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, the subject ordinance finds its legal support from Sections 16 and 18 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, which empower Local Government Units (LGUs) to exercise powers necessary of general welfare, efficient governance, and local fiscal autonomy;

Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that: "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."

WHEREAS, the amendments of the San Carlos City Hospital Consignment System through Ordinance No. 25-08 are a valid exercise of the City's administrative and fiscal authority. Section 18 of the Local Government Code empowers LGUs to establish and reorganize structures, systems, and procedures necessary for the effective implementation of local development plans. Consignment systems, as mechanisms to manage hospital supplies are administrative matters properly within the City's discretion provided they comply with the existing procurement laws and COA guidelines;

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental, which are:

*It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.
It must not be unfair or oppressive.
It must not be partial or discriminatory.
It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.
It must be general and consistent with public policy.
It must not be unreasonable.*

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr. unanimously seconded en masse during the regular session of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution, to wit:
