RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNOR TO SIGN, FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PROVINCE THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT TO BE ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL THROUGH IGNACIO L. ARROYO SR. MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL RELATIVE TO THE PROVISION OF A SHARED PHARMACY SERVICES AND A MEDICAL RECORDS OFFICER NEEDED BY THE MUNICIPALITY TO MEET THE UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE (UHC) ACT ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, thereby presented for appropriate action of the Board is the request for authority to the Provincial Governor to sign, for and in behalf of the province the Memorandum of Agreement to be entered into by and between the Province of Negros Occidental through Ignacio L. Arroyo Sr. Memorial District Hospital relative to the provision of a shared pharmacy services and a medical records officer needed by the municipality to meet the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act accreditation requirements;

WHEREAS, the agreement formalizes the partnership between the parties in providing the essential health human resource support for pharmacy services and medical records management to ensure the UHC and PhilHealth accreditation compliance;

WHEREAS, the agreement aligns with the objectives of the Universal Health Care Act (Republic Act No. 11223), which mandates the integration of local health systems and the establishment of province-wide and city-wide health systems.



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WHEREAS, it facilitates inter-LGU cooperation and resource sharing, which is important for strengthening the healthcare delivery network and ensuring access to essential health services, especially in meeting accreditation requirements for primary care providers;

WHEREAS, the MOA shall be effective upon signing and shall remain in force for one (1) year, renewable upon mutual agreement;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Finance, finding the same to be in order, deemed it best to approve the same;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Rommel T. Debulgado, duly seconded by all the members present,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to authorize the Provincial Governor to sign, for and in behalf of the province the Memorandum of Agreement to be entered into by and between the Province of Negros Occidental through Ignacio L. Arroyo Sr. Memorial District Hospital relative to the provision of a shared pharmacy services and a medical records officer needed by the municipality to meet the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act accreditation requirements.
