RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNOR TO SIGN, FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PROVINCE THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT TO BE ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL AND THE INTERNATIONAL CARE MINISTRIES FOUNDATION, INC. (ICMFI) RELATIVE TO THE COLLABORATION OF BOTH PARTIES IN THE TUBERCULOSIS ELIMINATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, thereby presented for appropriate action of the Board is the request for authority to the Provincial Governor to sign, for and in behalf of the province the Memorandum of Agreement to be entered into by and between the Province of Negros Occidental and the International Care Ministries Foundation, Inc. (ICMFI) relative to the collaboration of both parties in the Tuberculosis Elimination Program;

WHEREAS, the MOA provides the terms for a partnership between the Province of Negros Occidental, through its Provincial Health Office (PHO), and the ICMFI in implementing tuberculosis elimination programs;

WHEREAS, it is consistent with the Local Government Code of 1991, which vests upon local government units the responsibility to deliver basic health services, including the prevention and control of communicable diseases;

WHEREAS, is also aligns with the National Tuberculosis Control Program (NTP) under the Department of Health, which emphasizes active finding, treatment and patient support;

WHEREAS, the arrangement with ICMFI is non-financial in nature for the Province, except for the provision of existing PHO resources already within its mandate, and ICMFI contributes medication and logistical support, which is beneficial to the program;

WHEREAS, the subject MOA is effective upon signing, valid until December 2025, and renewable for three (3) years upon mutual agreement;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Health, finding the same to be in order, deemed it best to approve the same;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Araceli T. Somosa, duly seconded by all the members present,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to authorize the Provincial Governor to sign, for and in behalf of the province the Memorandum of Agreement to be entered into by and between the Province of Negros Occidental and the International Care Ministries Foundation, Inc. (ICMFI) relative to the collaboration of both parties in the Tuberculosis Elimination Program.
