**RESOLUTION NO. 1095

***RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2025-012 OF CITY OF SAGAY  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO DONATE ONE (1) UNIT UTILITY VEHICLE  
TO SAGAY CITY POLICE STATION AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE***

***WHEREAS***, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

***WHEREAS***, City Ordinance No. 2025-012 of City of Sagay authorizing the City Mayor to donate one (1) unit Utility Vehicle to Sagay City Police Station, was submitted for review by the City of Sagay to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

***WHEREAS***, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Sagay to enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

***WHEREAS***, in response to the need of the Sagay City Station for a utility vehicle to improve and maintain peace and order in the city, such donation is aligned with the provision of the Local Government Code that empowers local government units to act in furtherance of the public's general welfare, to wit:

*(Page 2 of SP Res. No. 1095, Series of 2025)*

*"Section 16. General Welfare. - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."*

**WHEREAS**, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, which are:

1. *It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.*
2. *It must not be unfair or oppressive.*
3. *It must not be partial or discriminatory.*
4. *It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.*
5. *It must be general and consistent with public policy.*
6. *It must not be unreasonable.*

**WHEREAS**, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Laws, recommends approval of the same;


**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr. and duly seconded by all the members present,

**THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED**, as it hereby resolves, to approve City Ordinance No. 2025-012 of City of Sagay authorizing the City Mayor to donate one (1) unit Utility Vehicle to Sagay City Police Station.
