RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2025-07 OF THE CITY OF LA CARLOTA, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL APPROVING THE 2025 GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 7 OF THE SAID CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (P10,000,000.00)

WHEREAS, thereby presented to the Board for review and appropriate action is the Appropriation Ordinance No. 2025-07 of the City of La Carlota, Negros Occidental approving the 2025 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 7 of the said city in the total amount of Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00) that was submitted to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review on October 16, 2025;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned budget shows apparent compliance in substance with the provisions of R.A 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, CY 2016 Updated Budget Operations Manual for Local Government Units, implementing circulars and other issuances as pre-reviewed and endorsed by the Local Finance Committee through the Provincial Budget Office;

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to approve Appropriation Ordinance No. 2025-07 of the City of La Carlota, Negros Occidental approving the 2025 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 7 of the said city in the total amount of Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00) subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of the Local Government Code of 1991 and the following conditions:

- The purchase and specifications of the motor vehicles shall be subject to the provisions of Administrative Order No. 14 dated December 10, 2018; Budget Circular (BC) No. 2022-1 dated February 11, 2022 and BC No. 2022-1A dated March 1, 2023, if the Department of Budget and Management (DBM);
- 2. The local government unit is encouraged to indicate the AIP reference codes under column three (3) of Local Budget Preparation Form No. 9 (Statement od Supplemental Appropriation). The AIP Reference Code is vital to ensuring the Plan-Budget Linkage. The code assigned to each PPA facilitates validation of whether or not the PPAs funded in the budget are the same PPAs prioritized in the AIP;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the accuracy of the statements/certifications and other supporting documents contained in this supplemental budget as well as observance with the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the city government.
