RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2025-03 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALATRAVA, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, COVERING THE FY 2025 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 3 OF THE SAID MUNICIPALITY IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY BILLION TWO HUNDRED EIGHT MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P50,208,800,000.00)

WHEREAS, thereby presented to the Board for review and appropriate action is the FY 2025 Supplemental Budget No. 3 of the Municipality of Calatrava, Negros Occidental with a total appropriation of Fifty Billion Two Hundred Eight Million Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (P50,208,800,000.00), enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan per Appropriation Ordinance No. 2025-03;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned budget shows apparent compliance in substance with the provisions of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, Budget Operations Manual for Local Government Units, 2023 Edition, implementing circulars and other issuances, as pre-reviewed and endorsed by the Provincial Budget Office and the Local Finance Committee;

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to approve and consider operative in its entirety effective November 17, 2025, the Appropriation Ordinance No. 2025-03 of the Municipality of Calatrava, Negros Occidental, subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of the Local Government Code of 1991 and to the following condition and reminder:

1. The purchase and specification of the motor vehicles shall be subject to the provisions of Administrative Order No. 14 dated December 10, 2018; Budget Circular No. 2022-1 dated February 11, 2022 and Budget Circular No. 2022-1A dated March 1, 2023 of the Department of Budget and Management;
2. The appropriation for Donations shall be spent solely for public purpose pursuant to Sections 305(b), 335 and 351 of the Local Government Code of 1991.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this Resolution does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the accuracy of the statement/certification and other supporting documents contained in this supplemental budget as well as observance with other existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the municipal government and compliance with the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the municipality.

ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
