RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 12, SERIES OF 2025 OF THE CITY OF SILAY, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, COVERING THE 2025 GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 9 OF THE SAID CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY FIVE MILLION ONE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVEN PESOS AND THIRTEEN CENTAVOS (P25,127,507.13)

WHEREAS, thereby presented for review and appropriate action of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan is the 2025 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 9 of the City of Silay, Negros Occidental with a total appropriation of P27,127,507.13, enacted by the Sanggunian Panlungsod per Appropriation Ordinance No. 12, series of 2025;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned budget shows apparent compliance in substance with the provisions of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and Joint Circular No. 93-2 of the Commission on Audit and the Department of Budget and Management dated June 8, 1993 and other implementing circulars and issuances, as pre-reviewed and endorsed by the Provincial Budget Officer and the Local Finance Committee;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Budget and Finance recommends approval of the same;

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to approve Appropriation Ordinance No. 12, series of 2025 of the City of Silay covering the 2025 General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 9 of the said city with a total appropriation of P25,127,507.13 and considered operative in its entirety effective December 26, 2025 subject to the posting requirement under Section 59 of LGC 1991 and subject to the following conditions and reminders:

1. the utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall be in accordance with the provisions of RA 10121, specifically Section 21, and its IRR, COA Circular No. 2012-02 dated September 12, 2012 and NDRRMC-DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013, furthermore, LDRRM Plan of the city should be reviewed by the Office of the Civil Defense pursuant to Section 7(e) of RA 10121; and
2. the LGU is encouraged to indicate the AIP reference codes under column three (3) of the LBPF No. 9 (Statement of Supplemental Appropriation). The AIP reference code is vital to ensuring the Plan-Budget Linkage. The code assigned to each PPA facilitates validation of whether or not the PPAs funded in the budget are the same PPAs prioritized in the AIP.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this review action does not authorize any item of appropriation that is specifically prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law and that the accuracy of the statement/certification and other supporting documents contained in this supplemental budget as well as the observance with other existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the city government.

ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
