RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 01-2026, SERIES OF 2026 OF THE CITY OF CADIZ, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL DECLARING TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF ROAD PORTION CABAHUG ST., BRGY. ZONE 2, FRONTING THE CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND, BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY THE CORNER OF GUSTILO BOULEVARD AND ON THE SOUTH BY VILLA BARBAS 1 STREET AND PEARL STREET, FOR THE 3RD DINAGSA FUN RIDE ACTIVITY ON JANUARY 17, 2026 FROM 5:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M. AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, City Ordinances No. 01-2026, series of 2026 of the City of Cadiz, Negros Occidental declaring temporary road closure of road portion Cabahug St., Brgy. Zone 2, fronting the Children's Playground, bounded on the North by the corner of Gustilo Boulevard and on the South by Villa Barbas 1 Street and Pearl Street, for the 3rd Dinagsa Fun Ride Activity on January 17, 2026 from 5:00AM to 6:00 PM was submitted for review by the City of Cadiz to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Cadiz to enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991," states under section 16 thereof that:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, Xxx."

WHEREAS, the subject ordinance also finds legal support from the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160). Section 21 (a) thereof provides, to wit:

" Closure and Opening of Roads. - (a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction: Provided, however, That in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided."

WHEREAS, Section 21 (c) further emphasizes that "any national or local road may be temporarily closed during fiesta celebrations.

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, which are:

1. *It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.*
2. *It must not be unfair or oppressive.*
3. *It must not be partial or discriminatory.*
4. *It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.*
5. *It must be general and consistent with public policy.*
6. *It must not be unreasonable.*

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Laws, recommends approval of the same;
