

RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2026-035 OF THE CITY OF VICTORIAS, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE QUEZON ST., ZONE 6 IN BARANGAY IV, FROM FEBRUARY 13, 2026 AT 1:00 P.M. UNTIL FEBRUARY 15, 2026 AT 4:00 P.M., IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR BARANGAY DAY CELEBRATION, AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 2026-035 of the City of Victorias, entitled: “AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE QUEZON ST., ZONE 6 IN BARANGAY IV, FROM FEBRUARY 13, 2026 AT 1:00 P.M. UNTIL FEBRUARY 15, 2026 AT 4:00 P.M., IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR BARANGAY DAY CELEBRATION”, was submitted for review by the City of Victorias to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Victorias to enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance of the City of Victorias find legal support from the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), specifically, Section 16, or the General Welfare Clause, which mandates that every local government unit shall exercise powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient governance and the promotion of the general welfare. Furthermore, Section 21 expressly authorizes a local government unit to temporarily close any local road falling within its jurisdiction pursuant to an ordinance;

WHEREAS, regarding City Ordinance No. 2026-035, the city mandates the temporary closure of Quezon St., Zone 6 in Barangay IV. This closure will take place starting February 13, 2026, at 1:00 P.M. until February 15, 2026, at 4:00 P.M. The purpose of this temporary closure is to facilitate the community's Barangay Day Celebration. To ensure the public's safety and well-being during the event, the ordinance strictly requires that cleanliness be properly maintained and that peace and order be always upheld;

WHEREAS, the ordinance complies with the six (6) generally accepted principles for a valid ordinance, as adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental under Resolution No. 1206, which are:

1. *It must not contravene the Constitution or any statute.*
2. *It must not be unfair or oppressive.*
3. *It must not be partial or discriminatory.*
4. *It must not prohibit but may regulate trade.*
5. *It must be general and consistent with public policy.*
6. *It must not be unreasonable.*

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr., unanimously seconded by all the members present,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2026-035 OF THE CITY OF VICTORIAS, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE QUEZON ST., ZONE 6 IN BARANGAY IV, FROM FEBRUARY 13, 2026 AT 1:00 P.M. UNTIL FEBRUARY 15, 2026 AT 4:00 P.M., IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR BARANGAY DAY CELEBRATION AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE.
