RESOLUTION DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2026-002 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, DECLARING EVERY MARCH 25 AND MAY 16 AS SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAYS IN THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG IN CONNECTION WITH ITS ANNUAL MUNICIPAL FIESTA AND FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY, RESPECTIVELY, AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Bayan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 2026-002 of the Municipality of Ilog, Negros Occidental, entitled: "*AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EVERY MARCH 25 AND MAY 16 AS SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAYS IN THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG IN CONNECTION WITH ITS ANNUAL MUNICIPAL FIESTA AND FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY, RESPECTIVELY*", was submitted for review by the Municipality of Ilog to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, after prompt examination by the Provincial Legal Office, it is the recommendation of the said Office that the subject Ordinance is within the conferred power of the

Sangguniang Bayan of Ilog enact, thus, the same may be given due course by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 2026-002, issued by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Ilog, Negros Occidental, has been reviewed and is found to conform with the applicable provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 2026-002 is legally grounded on the provision of Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, which states:

Section 16. General Welfare. - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

WHEREAS, the ordinance appropriately provides for the continuity of essential services (health, disaster response, and peace and order) during these holidays and ensures compliance with existing national laws and labor regulations;

WHEREAS, the reviewing authority of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds no irregularity that follow thereto as a result of the thorough scrutiny of the Provincial Legal Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Sixto Teofilo Roxas V. Guanzon, Jr., unanimously seconded by all the members present,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to pass and approve this resolution, to wit:

RESOLUTION DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2026-002 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL, DECLARING EVERY MARCH 25 AND MAY 16 AS SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAYS IN THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY OF ILOG IN CONNECTION WITH ITS ANNUAL MUNICIPAL FIESTA AND FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY, RESPECTIVELY, AS A VALID ENACTED ORDINANCE.
