RESOLUTION APPROVING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2025-028 OF THE CITY OF SIPALAY, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL REQUIRING A MANDATORY INFANT AND CHILDREN HEALTH IMMUNIZATION IN THE CITY OF SIPALAY, PROVIDING SUCH GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREFOR TO 17 BARANGAYS OF SIPALAY CITY

WHEREAS, Section 56 of the Local Government Code of 1991 expresses the reviewing power of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on Component City and Municipal Ordinances and Resolutions declaring the Ordinance or Resolution valid if it is consistent with the law or invalid in whole or in part if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds the Ordinance or Resolution to be beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned;

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 2025-028 of the City of Sipalay, Negros Occidental requiring a mandatory Infant and Children Health Immunization in the City of Sipalay, providing such guidelines in the implementation therefor to 17 barangays of Sipalay City was submitted for review by the City of Sipalay to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, the subject ordinance seeks to promote the health and safety of the residents of Sipalay City. It is legally grounded on provisions on general welfare found in Section 16 of the Local Government Code, to wit:

Section 16. General Welfare. - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the SP Committee on Health recommends approval of the same;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Araceli T. Somosa and duly seconded by all the members present,

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN RESOLVED, as it hereby resolves, to approve Municipal Ordinance No. 2025-028 of the City of Sipalay, Negros Occidental requiring a mandatory Infant and Children Health Immunization in the City of Sipalay, providing such guidelines in the implementation therefor to 17 barangays of Sipalay City.
